IATI STEM EDUCATION WORK GROUP: THE NATIONAL CYBER CHAMPIONSHIP



IATI STEM Education Work Group is a group of leading GMs of R&D Centers of Multinational Corporations in Israel, alongside representatives from the Ministry of Education and Military Technological Units working to promote STEM Education in Israel.

The Work Group finds solutions for the shortage of engineers in Israel in the short and long term, and focuses on growing the engineering and technical capacity for high-tech in Israel. Through projects, actions and initiatives, the work group strives to eventually increase the number and quality of graduating students in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).

IATI STEM Education Work Group's flagship project is **The National Cyber Championship**, a collaboration between the Ministry of Education, IATI and the Rashi Foundation. This Coding and Mathematics yearly competition draws more than 300,000 participants from 1st to 12th grade in over 2,000 schools across the country.

- Over 300,000 competitors
- Ages 6-18
- Over 2,000 schools
- 6 championships
- Variety of coding challenges
- 60 million math challenges solved
- Over 30 contributing high-tech companies
